Purpose

Our reasons for having a parents club are three-fold:

- Support the *Central Bucks South Football* players and coaches.
- Develop a cohesive network of parents to provide that support.
- Enjoy together our sons' athletic experience at C. B. High School South.

The support we need comes in the form of attendance at games, meetings, fundraisers, and social gatherings. It also needs a small contribution of time, energy and ideas.

History

The current Parents Club was started with the opening of C B South. It was modeled after similar clubs at our sister schools, CB West and CB East.

Membership

Anyone who is a parent of a current *Central Bucks South Football* player is automatically a member of the *Central Bucks South Football* Parents Club. All parents receive communications about club activities and are welcome to participate in planning club activities.

Board Members

Board members consist of 2 parents as co-presidents from each senior, junior and sophomore class, 1 secretary and 1 treasurer.

Monthly Football Parent Meeting

Once a month the Football Parents Club meets, to get updates, share information, receive the financial reports, and plan /organize for all the activities throughout the year. Reminders are sent via email.

Activities

The following is a listing of the activities that the Parents Club sponsors and supports throughout the year:

Pre-Game day meal- meal for all players dressing for the game and managers. Held in the Cafeteria 3:00-3:30pm the day of the game. Parents Club donates Gatorade and Water, supervises meal and requests cafeteria use.

Post Game Meal and Social - Meal organized for all players, managers, coaches and cheerleaders held after **Home** games. Parents bring snacks for family members to enjoy and socialize while the team eats a post-game meal. This is open to all team members, including junior varsity and sophomore players.

Post Game Away- Sandwiches (usually Hoagies) are ordered for all players, coaches and managers for all varsity games

Half time Fruit-Volunteers donate fruit for half time. . We need to buy it, cut it and give it to the managers before the game starts. (Bananas, Grapes and Oranges).

Senior Dinner- Senior player's parents host a meal the night before each game in their home for all the senior players and managers (at own expense).

Clothing Sales- *Central Bucks South Football* clothing sold at home games and back-to-school nights

J.V. team- Parent club sponsors a post game snack and 2 post game meals.

Sales at Home games – Volunteers sell 50/50 tickets and Game ball raffle tickets.

Replica Jerseys- Football Jersey with players name and number made available for purchase. Jerseys can be worn by parents, family members etc. to all *Central Bucks South Football* games.

Program Committee- A committee that solicits for both business and personal ads, in addition to designing and selling the programs at all home games.

Photographer- Professional who takes pictures at Varsity and J.V. games and all team events, (picnic, camp).

Fundraiser- Parent Club main fundraiser, which every player is expected to participate. All proceeds are used to support the *Central Bucks South Football* program and benefit all players.

Dues- Amount determined by club yearly, and collected from all players.

Spirit Pack- Purchased by every player and is required by the Coach. Consists of *Central Bucks South* logo sweatshirt, sweat pants, 2 t-shirt, and shorts.

Banquet- Football banquet held in December each year.

Picnic- Held in August at the end of Football Camp. This is a picnic for all players and their families. Sponsored by Outback Steakhouse, Jamison.

Football Camp- 2 weeks in August with dates and schedule determined by the coach.

Mother's night/Father's night- parents of players are announced at a football game.

Golf Outing- Major fundraiser sponsored by parents club, held at a local golf course. Event is organized and run by parent volunteers.

Facility Usage forms- form required by Central Bucks School district for using classrooms for meetings.

7 on 7- Scrimmage games which players are invited to attend by the coach.

Cheerleading/Band Liaison- representative from Cheerleading/Band who attends football meetings and reports to cheerleading/band all important dates and events.

Corporate sponsors- Donations from large corporations solicited by parent club volunteers. Funds used to support the *Central Bucks South Football* program.
